

Toronto Says, "It is exposing the bandas"

"Toronto is doing its best in exposing the bandas" says, Ato Demelash Mersha, Chairman of Kinijit Toronto Chapter in Canada. He was referring to the visit of Berhanu Nega (Phd), who was faced with a protest by a group of Ethiopians that accuses him for dismantlement of Kinijit. Demelash finally called for his compatriots "to weed out traitors and betrayers" " Flaks" he said" Follow Toronto's example and weed out traitors and betrayers who are selling the people's struggle"

Dr. Berhanu has been in Toronto again and again whilst the two nationalist leaders Eng Hailu Shawel and Taye Wolde Semayat were denied of entry visa. The question that the demonstrators raise is concentrated on the fact that those who negotiate on the interest of Ethiopia are welcome in Canada whereas those who demand for national respect and mutual benefit are rejected.

There have been an atmosphere of difference between those who support Birtukan Mediksa and Berhanu Nega in the past few weeks but they all look like alike now. It seems that the descending parties are playing a tripartite alliance with Berhanu handling the negotiation with Westerners on the sell of our national interest, Birtukan dealing with EPRDF as to how to make Kinijit a loyal opposition and Andargachew dealing with Eritrea to confront Woyanie if plan for peaceful negotiation fails; some observers say.
